The Committee makes no guarantee that individuals will be assigned to help in a specific workshop, however. This is a *service project* and a great deal of your time will be spent getting workshop leaders and their equipment to and from their classrooms. You may have some "quiet time", so you may wish to bring homework projects, a book, or something else to occupy your time. This is also a great opportunity to meet other Girl Scouts, make new friends, share goals, and learn about one another's activities and interests.

Please fill out the attached application and return it with a recent photo and a letter of recommendation from your troop leader *by January 5, 2018.* You will be notified of the date and time of your interview. We will conduct interviews by phone. All new AND returning Assistants must participate in a phone interview in order to be considered for the Assistant position, even if you have been requested by a specific Workshop Leader to help solely in his/her workshop(s).

It is very important that a parent/guardian be available to talk to the Discoveree Committee member conducting the phone interview so he/she is fully aware of the expectations and rewards of being an Assistant at Discoveree 2018.
