You may have some "quiet time", so you may wish to bring homework projects, a book, or something else to occupy your time. Please fill out the attached application and return it with a recent photo and a letter of recommendation from your troop leader **by December 17, 2018.** You will be notified of the date and time of your interview. We will conduct interviews by phone. All new AND returning Assistants must participate in a phone interview in order to be considered for the Assistant position, even if you have been requested by a specific Workshop Leader to help solely in his/her workshop(s).

It is very important that a parent/guardian be available to talk to the Discoveree Committee member conducting the phone interview so he/she is fully aware of the expectations and rewards of being an Assistant at Discoveree 2019.
